

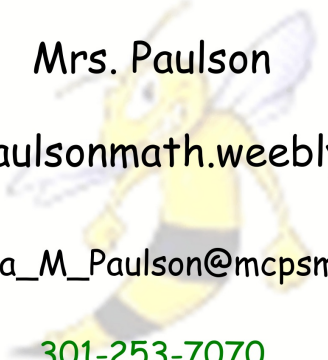

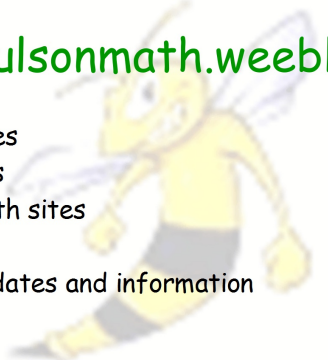

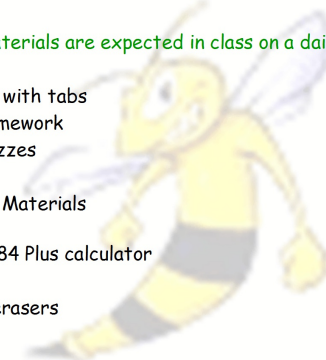

Materials

The following materials are expected in class on a daily basis:

Classroom Conduct

Homework

- Homework will be assigned each class (refer to the course syllabus) and we will go over the assignment during the next class.
- It is **YOUR RESPONSIBILITY** to complete homework and ask questions.
- Periodically I will check homework for completeness and I will give unannounced (open note) homework quizzes. Homework quizzes are not re-assessable.

Assessments

- Tests and major quizzes will always be included on the course calendar.
- **If you are absent the day before the test or quiz OR miss the review and no new tested material is presented, you are expected to take the test/quiz with the class on the announced day.**
- Make arrangements with me for a missed test/quiz due to a lawful (excused) absence. An unlawful (unexcused) absence doesn't show a "good faith effort"; therefore, any graded work collected on the day of an unexcused absence will receive a zero.

Re-Assessment

- Maximum of one per quarter and the re-assessable quiz will be announced. MCPS policy states that: The re-assessment score will take precedence over the first score.
- I will inform you of the date and time that the re-assessment will be given. Eligibility requirements for re-assessment:
 - You must take the quiz on the original quiz day.
 - I must agree that you gave a "good faith effort" on the original assessment.
 - You received complete credit for homework collected prior to the quiz.

Grades

Grades are calculated as follows:

- Homework for practice = 10%
- All other tasks and assessments = 90%

According to MCPS policy, your final semester grade is calculated from the two quarter grades (75%) and the final exam (25%). In order to ensure a passing grade for the semester DHS math department policy states that you need a passing grade for at least two of the three grades.

Getting Help

- Although I provide periodic progress reports, please check edline regularly. See me immediately for any discrepancies. You should never "wonder" what your approximate grade is in this class.
- If you need extra help, see me (don't wait until it is too late!) to arrange a time. I am available:
